1) *Accreditation*

Academic accreditation in Canada is a process of quality assurance through which accredited status is granted to a program of study once it has met certain standards of education established by the responsible authorities.

2) *Post-secondary*

Post-secondary education is “higher education”. Admission into a program of higher education, requires that a student normally has completed a high school level education, or its equivalent.

3) *Professional programs*
