

PEAC Governance Committee Call for Applications

Physiotherapy Education Accreditation Canada (*PEAC*) is pleased to announce a call for applications to be considered for nomination to the PEAC Governance Committee.

PEAC is a federal not-for-profit corporation governed by a volunteer Board of Directors. PEAC administers accreditation programs for physiotherapy education programs and occupational therapist assistant / physiotherapist assistant education programs in Canada (as the Occupational Therapist Assistant and Physiotherapist Assistant Education Accreditation Program, OTA & PTA EAP). The OTA & PTA EAP is jointly governed by PEAC and the Canadian Association of Occupational Therapists (*CAOT*).

The PEAC Governance Committee is a standing committee of the Board of Directors. The principal objectives of the Governance Committee are to review governance matters of the Board (including solicitation of nominations of individuals qualified to be Directors) and the Corporation and to assist the Board in governing the organization effectively. The term of office is two years renewable twice to a maximum of six years. For further details on the committee composition and responsibilities, please refer to the *Governance Committee Terms of Reference*.

PEAC is currently seeking an external accreditation member. Candidates must be available to attend 2-hour virtual meetings 3-4 times per year, including additional work between meetings as needed. The successful candidate will be appointed to the committee in September 2023 and will attend their first Governance Committee meeting in October 2023. Their first two-year term will end in August 2025.

To reflect the diversity of our community partners and profession, we encourage applications from persons identifying with equity-deserving groups including BIPOC, Indigenous Peoples, persons of diverse sexual orientation, gender identity or expression (LGBTQ2S+) and others. Please note that the work of the committee is conducted in English.
